

Body	27" x WOF	33" x WOF	37" x WOF	20" x 32"
Border	10" x WOF	10" x WOF	10" x WOF	9" x 32"
Accent (Trim)	3" x WOF	3" x WOF	3" x WOF	3" x 32"

- 1. Lay 10" border fabric right side up on the work surface.
- 2. Lay main fabric of pillowcase right side up on top of the border fabric. Line up raw edges at top and sides.

 Raw Edges (top)
- Press the 3" accent fabric in half lengthwise, wrong side together, lay pressed 3" accent fabric on top of main fabric. Line up raw edges at top and sides.
- 4. Roll the main fabric from the bottom up to inside the 10" border fabric.
- Bring the bottom edge of the 10" border fabric to the top edge of all fabrics.Line up raw edges at top and sides. Pin the raw edges across the top.
- 6. Stitch ½" seam along the pinned edge. You now have a tube of fabric. Turn the tube inside out and your pillowcase is almost finished.
- 7. Finish the side and bottom edges with a serger seam or use a French seam*. Put the wrong sides of the fabrics together and sew a scant ¼" seam on the side and along the bottom edge.
- 8. Turn the pillowcase inside out, so the right sides of the fabric are together. Sew a 3/8" 1/2" seam down the side and along the bottom edge enclosing the raw edges.
- 9. Turn the pillowcase right side out, press.



*A French seam hides all the raw edges from showing inside your pillowcase.
